VINEYARD

Dineen Vineyard

Originally developed in 2001 and located in Zillah, Washington, the vineyard spans an elevation of 1050-1140 feet. The overall site is characterized by a gentle, south facing slope. Vines are bilateral cordon pruned and planted on Harvard-Burke silt loam and Scoon silt loam

Wienbau Vineyard

First planted in 1981, this is a relatively warm site due to its 710-950 ft elevation. The site is characterized by a gentle south facing slope and Kennewick silt loam soils.

VINTAGE

Growing Season 2018 was considered a near perfect growing season. Warmer

than average temperatures throughout the year, allowed grapes to ripen steadily. Despite wildfires leading up harvest season, many vineyards such as ours were not negatively impacted by smoke. Because the smoke was high enough in the atmosphere it allowed for some cooling affect in the

hottest months.
