

2018 Malbec Gamache Vineyard Columbia Valley AVA

VINEYARD

Site Gamache Vineyard was initially planted in 1982. Located on the

white bluffs overlooking Basin City, the vineyard spans an elevation of 804-960 feet. The overall site is characterized by a gentle, mile long southwestern slope. The Malbec is planted on an eastern facing portion helping to preserve the grapes'

acidity.

Soil Primarily Warden sandy loam, which provides ample drainage

for vines as well as curbing vine vigor.

Planted Malbec planted in 2003

VINTAGE

Growing Season 2018 was considered a near perfect growing season. Warmer

than average temperatures throughout the year, allowed grapes to ripen steadily. Despite wildfires leading up harvest season, many vineyards such as ours were not negatively impacted by smoke. Because the smoke was high enough in the atmosphere it allowed for some cooling affect in the

hottest months.

twice daily, until the desired tannin structure developed. After primary fermentation was complete, malolactic fermentation

occurred in barrel.
